Great Plains Communications Awards Grant to Develop an Aquaponics Lab for Perkins County Elementary School

April 23, 2019 (Blair, Neb.) - Great Plains Communications presented the Perkins County Elementary School with a \$2,500 grant on April 17 to support the development of an Aquaponics Lab. Aquaponics is the combination of aquaculture (raising fish) and hydroponics (growing plants without soil) that grows fish and

plants together in one combined system.



"Aquaponics is a great hands-on approach to help teach the benefits of the interaction between the earth's systems and it allows the students to be involved in the scientific processes on a daily basis," said Amanda Wood, Science Teacher at Perkins County Elementary. Ms. Wood believes that children need to be exposed to the amazing areas of science at an early age to ignite their passion to seek and understand more of the world around them.

Teachers will work together to construct the Aquaponics system and to incorporate concepts from all subject areas to allow for both current and future students to benefit from the project.

"We found this concept to be educational and very interesting for young students as they watch the concept come to life," said Laura Kocher, Marketing and Public Relations Director for Great Plains Communications.
